

HOW TO GET YOUR iPhone UP AND RUNNING


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ACTIVATING YOUR iPhone

When you first take your iPhone out of the box you will need to insert your SIM card using the SIM eject tool which can be found in the box attached to the inside of the booklet.


Note. Ensure your new SIM number is to hand when registering. Once the SIM is active you may need to turn your device off then back on in order to activate the data connection.



- Insert the end of the SIM eject tool into the hole in the SIM tray.
 Press firmly and push it straight in until the tray pops out. If you do not have a SIM eject tool, you can use a paper clip.
- Pull out the SIM tray and place the SIM card in to the tray.The angled corner of the SIM guides you on how it should be placed into the tray as it will only fit one way.
- 3. With the tray aligned, carefuly replace the SIM tray containing the SIM card into the iPhone.

RIGHT! WHAT'S NEXT?

If you have not already, turn on the device by pressing the power button located on the top of the device.



Once your iPhone has powered up you will see this screen. This means you are now ready to set up the device. As it says on the screen, slide to set up.

Note. Remember to back up your old iPhone before you begin so you can restore it to your new device via the iCloud or iTunes.



STEP BY STEP ACTIVATION

STEP1 LANGUAGE

Choose your language.

STEP 2 COUNTRY OR REGION



Select your Country or Region.

STEP 3 WI-FI NETWORK




Choose your network from the list of available networks and enter your password if required.

STEP 4 ACTIVATING



Your device will now contact the Apple servers to activate your iPhone.

STEP 5 LOCATION SERVICES



Enable or Disable Location Services, this allows your device to find your location for apps such as Maps and Photos.

STEP 6 SET UP



Choose to Setup as new or if you have a backup from a previous iPhone, you can restore from the iCloud or iTunes. For more info turn to the 'Content Transfer' section.

STEP 7 APPLE ID



Create or enter your Apple ID in order to access the App Store and iTunes,

You must have an Apple ID to download apps and music from the App Store.

STEP 8 T'S & C'S



Browse through the T's & C's. You will need to tap Agree to proceed. Tap Agree once again when the popup appears.

STEP 9 PASSCODE



Create a 4 digit passcode of your choice to protect your device.


Tap 'Don't add a passcode' to skip this step.

STEP 10 SIRI



Turn Siri On or Off. Siri is like a Personal Assistant for your iPhone.

STEP 11 DIAGNOSTICS



Choose whether to send diagnostic data to Apple to help improve their products and services.

STEP 12 THAT'S IT!



You're now ready to enjoy your new device. Tap 'Get Started' to proceed.

CONTENT TRANSFER

TRANSFERRING INFORMATION FROM YOUR CURRENT iPhone TO A NEW iPhone VIA iCloud OR iTunes



iCloud

- Back up your old device to iCloud by going to Settings > ICloud > Backup and toggling iCloud Backup on.
 Ensure that your device is connected to Wi-Fi and connected to a power source before backing up.
 Note. The time required to back up and restore from a backup depends on the amount of data contained in the backup and on the speed of your internet connection.
- iCloud backs up your device once a day. If your device needs to be backed up before migrating, tap Back Up Now in Settings > ICloud > Backup. Do not begin migration before the backup is finished to ensure all data has been backed up.



3. When the backup of your old device is finished, turn on your new device and complete the set up assistant by selecting your language and country then choose whether to enable Location Services. When prompted, choose your Wi-Fi network.

- 4. When you reach the 'Set up your iPhone' section, choose 'Restore from iCloud Backup' then tap Next. Enter your Apple ID and password to continue.
- Select the backup of your old device and tap Restore. Wait until the device has finished restoring from the backup.



6. When the restore process is complete, your device will restart. When it turns back on it will be ready for use. You should connect the device to iTunes to sync data not contained in the backup (such as music, videos, apps). You can verify and change the data that's synced by clicking the syncing tabs in iTunes
Note. When restoring an iCloud backup to a new device, you wil need to re-enter your passwords for your Apple ID, email and other accounts.



CONTENT TRANSFER

TRANSFERRING INFORMATION FROM YOUR CURRENT iPhone TO A NEW iPhone VIA iCloud OR iTunes



iTunes

- 1. Verify that you have installed the latest version of iTunes and the latest version of iOS before continuing. If you are unsure how to update iTunes, go to http://support.apple.com/kb/HT5654 to find out more.
- 2. Back up your old device using iTunes and transfer your data from your device to your computer. Go to http://support.apple.com/kb/ht4946 for more information on how to backup through iTunes.
- 3. Turn on your new device and complete the setup assistant by selecting your language and country then choose whether to enable Location Services. When prompted, choose your Wi-Fi network.
- 4. When you reach the 'Set up your iPhone' section, select 'Restore from iTunes Backup'.
- 5. Connect your new device to iTunes (on the same computer you used to backup your current iPhone). iTunes will ask you to restore from backup or set up as new. Select the backup of your old device and choose Continue.

Note. During the process of restoring your old backup to a new iPhone, you may see the iTunes progree bar pause. If this occurs, please allow for additional time for the restore to complete.

6. When the restore process is complete, your device will restart. When it turns back on it will be ready for use. You should keep your device connected to iTunes to sync data not contained in the backup (such as music, videos, apps). You can verify and change the data that's synced by clicking the syncing tabs in iTunes.

Note. If you restored from an unencrypted backup, you will need to re-enter your passwords for your Apple ID, email and other accounts.

Additional Information

iTunes and iOS do not support installing backups of newer versions of iOS onto devices using earlier versions of iOS. If your backup was taken from a device that has a newer version of iOS installed, update your new device before transferring the information.



HOW TO ADD AN EMAIL ACOUNT

Adding an email account to your iPhone makes life easier by having your email whilst on the go. To add your email account follow the below easy steps.

1. TAP SETTINGS



6. iPhone WILL VERIFY ACCOUNT



2. TAP MAIL, CONTACTS, CALENDARS



7. VERIFIED



3. TAP ADD ACCOUNT



8. CHOOSE WHAT TO SYNC THEN TAP SAVE



4. SELECT EMAIL PROVIDER



5. ENTER YOUR DETAILS



In step 4 you wil be presented with a list of the most popular email providers. If your provider is not listed then tap **Other** and manually enter your providers details

Once your device has finished you will be taken to your list of email accounts. If you wish to add more than one account then repeat from step 3. Or if you want to view your mail, press the home key and tap the Mall icon.
