

GUIDE FOR USING AN EE POWER BAR

Don't

- Treat the Power Bar roughly. The bars contain a lithium battery. They are robust but not indestructible.
- Do not drop it on to hard surfaces, it is built to withstand a few bumps but repeated impacts may break something inside.
- Do not unplug the cable by pulling the wire section.
- Do not attempt to recharge the bar and charge your device at the same time. It might possibly overheat, but it is definitely not efficient to do so.
- Do not stand the bar up on end when using it to charge your phone. If it falls it may damage the connectors on the cable or in your phone.
- Do not poke anything inside the sockets on the bar or the adapter's metal sections. If the connectors will not insert easily something is out of line. Return it to an EE store and tell them there is a problem so that they do not put it into the swap boxes.
- Do not expose the bar or cable to extremes of temperature, for example do not leave it in a parked car where it could get very cold in winter or very hot in summer.
- If charging from a laptop or desktop computer, do not leave it next to the cooling fan where it may get hot.
- Do not leave the bar or cable in the sun for long periods where it may get hot.
- Do not attempt to dismantle the bar, there are no user serviceable parts.
- Do not use the cable if it or the connectors are damaged in any way. Return it to an EE store.
- Do not use the bar in damp atmospheres such as bathrooms or kitchens or swimming pools.
- If you drop the bar on to a hard surface, say from more than 30 cm (1 ft), do not continue to use it. There may be no visible damage but the battery could become dislodged. Return it to an EE store and tell them there is a problem so that they do not put it into the swap boxes.
- Do not point the light at people's eyes, it is powerful.
- Do not clean the bar with liquids.

Do

- Use the cable provided or another good quality cable. Cheap cables are easily damaged, poor quality wires and connectors may damage the bar or your device.
- Grip the flat part of the connector behind the metal part when inserting and removing the cable from the bar, mains charger or your phone.
- Keep the bar away from heat and moisture.
- Keep it away from loose dust or dirt. If you think something might have got into the bar take it back to an EE store.
- Use a dry cloth to wipe the bar or cable if it gets dirty.
- Keep the bar in a soft bag when not in use.
- Unplug the cables for storage. You might distort the pins if you leave the connectors plugged in in a confined space.
